


Don't gamble with compliance

Sanctions, tariffs, and trade restrictions between major economies like the US, China, and the EU are increasing, making it essential for air carriers to adapt to new regulations swiftly. The pressure to meet ESG requirements also extends compliance obligations beyond traditional trade regulations, impacting investment prospects if standards are unmet.

Hefty fines, halted shipments, damaged reputations, and jail time are just the beginning.

With stringent enforcement of trade sanctions, air carriers must exercise enhanced due diligence to avoid transporting prohibited goods or dealing with sanctioned entities. As the air cargo industry strives for speed and reliability, maintaining compliance is not just a regulatory necessity—it's key to staying competitive and ensuring operational integrity.



The cargo journey: a complex web of compliance

The cargo transportation process involves multiple stages, each laden with compliance checks and paperwork.

The journey begins when the shipper sends a proposal request to the freight forwarder. This initial step triggers thefirst round of compliance checks and documentation, setting the foundation for the entire process.

Next, the freight forwarder plays a critical role by conducting a compliance screening, planning the shipment, and confirming the booking with the carrier. This stage involves managing key documents like the Bill of Lading, cargo manifests, and compliance certificates, ensuring that all parties and goods meet regulatory standards.

Finally, upon receiving the booking, the carrier steps in to perform its own compliance checks and notify the freight forwarder. The freight forwarder then prepares the shipment, assembling and verifying documents such as export licenses and customs declarations before sending them to the carrier.

In the last step, the carrier conducts a final screening, reviews the Air Waybill and other relevant documents, and loads the shipment onto the plane.

The process relies heavily on thorough documentation and compliance verification at each stage.










ITTS compliance screening services

Screening involves checking the names of individuals, organizations, vessels, and countries against databases compiled by local and international bodies.

It plays a crucial role in identifying potential sanctions violations. However, screening is not easy. Government watchlists are scattered across different formats, locations, and languages, often with poor-quality data. The same issues exist with transaction data. Common challenges like missing information, spelling variations, aliases, and data input errors (such as typos) can result in false positives or missed matches.



ITTS provides the following screening services:



Transaction Screening

All transaction elements, such as articles, parties (consigner, consignee, agent, etc.), and itinerary, are screened in one process. If any combination of these elements matches a watchlist, ITTS alerts the user, providing an overview of the lists and a probability score for each match.



Vessel / Aircraft Screening

Screening vessels or aircraft against sanctions lists by extracting data like vessel IMO numbers and aircraft ICAO tail numbers from unstructured watchlist text. After that, ITTS sorts the data into its own category and make it searchable.



Party Screening

Screening parties against sanctions, PEPs, law enforcement, export controls, adverse media, and internal blacklists using advanced search algorithms.



Article Screening

Screening articles using HS codes or descriptions against sanctions, dual-use, controlled goods, and military goods lists.



Location Screening

Identify risks by screening location data, including addresses, postal codes, cities, and countries. It scans itineraries to detect sanctioned or high-risk locations, including potential transshipment points, ensuring comprehensive risk assessment.

Comprehensive screening coverage

Access to over 1,000 restricted party lists, including denied individuals and entities, Politically Exposed Persons, embargoed or sanctioned countries, and high-risk regions. This also covers high-risk ownership entities tied to forced labor, state ownership, sanctioned status, and Ultimate Beneficial Ownership concerns.



Advanced transshipment detection

ITTS detects and flags suspicious shipments passing through transshipment countries known for sanction evasion. Configurable options allow you to adjust these lists based on your organization's risk tolerance. Transit countries in shipment itineraries can also be screened for export restrictions.



Enhanced screening accuracy

With global coverage, ITTS provides superior screening accuracy. Our method goes beyond basic string proximity searches by correlating HS/CN codes with ECCN, ensuring more precise compliance checks.



Supply chain and goods risk management

Assess risks for restricted goods and munitions, including those targeted by specific sanctions (e.g., Russia and Belarus). ITTS also effectively monitors supply chain risks.



Policy-based compliance automation

The policy-based assessment feature automates the compliance review process, reducing manual work for your team. It resolves red flags automatically using predefined company policies or official declarations from shippers and freight forwarders, especially for country and commodity-based checks.



Predictable and nonlinear pricing

ITTS uses a transaction-level pricing model (for both cargo and passenger bookings), not based on the number of screening elements. You can screen a single transaction multiple times throughout its lifecycle without incurring extra costs.

The manual processes of verifying and validating shipments against export control regulations and sanctions listed by various regulatory bodies such as OFAC, UN Security Council, and EU presented operational hurdles. These challenges included time-consuming manual checks, the risk of errors, and delays.

Solution & application

In a successful collaboration with our esteemed partner Canon, flydubai implemented ITTS. ITTS combines knowledge about goods classification with regulations and data sources to automatically check transactions for compliance.

ITTS receives Air Waybills from flydubai's Booking and Cargo Management systems, checks all aspects of the Air Waybills for compliance with **export control and sanctions**, and returns the results to the requestor.

The case management capability assigns flagged transactions to a compliance officer who can inspect the compliance check results, validate them, attach evidence to substantiate the conclusion, and submit the results for approval.

Any non-compliant shipments are refused, and authorities are notified, depending on the nature of the non-compliance. ITTS automates policy-based compliance assessment, which improved the efficiency of the compliance officers' work by more than 85% (85% true positive hits less to assess manually).




